Low-Cost Spay/Neuter *Be a responsible pet owner. Pets should be spayed and neutered to prevent more unwanted animals, make a better behaved pet and improve the health of your cat or dog.*

- **SNSI (Spay/Neuter Services of Indiana, Inc.)** www.SpayNeuterServices.org - A nonprofit organization providing low-cost spay/neuter certificates for dogs and cats in partnership with many central Indiana veterinary clinics. Year-round program is available to pet owners who meet income requirements; twice a year program is open to all pet owners, regardless of income (February and October). To receive a spay/neuter information packet, call voice mail 767-7771.
- **FACE Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Clinic** www.facespayneuter.org - 1505 Massachusetts Avenue, Indianapolis, IN 46201. Low-cost spaying and neutering for dogs and cats, plus vaccinations and other basic wellness services. They have no income qualifications. Ph: 638-3223.
- **Low-Cost Spay Neuter Clinic** www.lowcostclinic.org - 1721A Pleasant Street, Noblesville, IN 46060. Low-cost spaying and neutering for cats and dogs. In addition, the clinic offers vaccination clinics and TNR assistance for stray and feral cats. Ph: 706-0537.
- **SNIP (Spay Neuter Indiana Pets, Inc.)** www.spayneuterindianapets.com - A nonprofit organization offering low cost spay/neuter assistance for pet dogs and cats. Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) Assistance *Help reduce the stray and feral cat overpopulation*

If you are feeding outdoor cats (stray or feral) in Marion County, you are required by the city's TNR ordinance to spay/neuter, vaccinate, and eartip for identification all the cats in your colony (group) and be registered with Indyferal.

- **IndyFeral** www.indyferal.org - Offers Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) assistance within Marion County. Stray and feral (wild) cats are humanely trapped, examined, vaccinated, provided an eartip for identification and sterilized by a veterinarian. Medical care is provided as needed. Cats that are too wild for adoption are returned to their familiar outdoor habitat and monitored by their caretakers. Food bank and cat shelter assistance is available to registered caretakers as resources allow. Indyferal encourages caretakers to utilize local adoption groups to assist with adoption of tame cats/kittens if needed. TNR referrals provided for those outside of Marion County. Ph: 596-2300.

Report Animal Cruelty /Abandonment *It does not matter if the animal is a pet, stray or wild animal.*

Spay/neuter and vaccination assistance is available. Income eligibility will apply. Ph: 592-9616.
