Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Dogs and cats can be fixed as early as 3 months of age BEFORE their first litter. Your pet will be healthier, happier, and better behaved for it too.

- **Fix-A-Bull Program**: Open to pit bulls and pit bull mixes. Dog must look like "pit bull", the most common breed entering the city animal shelter. Includes spay/neuter, rabies vaccination, and DHLPP vaccination for \$20. Contact FACE at 638-3223 to schedule an appointment.
- **46201 Zip Code Program:** Casa del Toro, a local pit bull education and advocacy group, offers free spay/neuter surgeries for dogs and cats in the 46201 zip code. Neighborhood Cat Program Are you feeding friendly strays or feral cats you can't touch?

If you are feeding neighborhood cats in Marion County, you are required by the city's Trap-Neuter-Return (TNR) ordinance to fix, vaccinate, and eartip for identification all the cats in your colony (group) and be registered with IndyFeral.

Neighborhood Cat Package

- Includes spay/neuter, ear-tip, rabies, and flea treatment, if needed, for \$20.
- Neighborhood cats in 46201, 46203, 46227, 46221, 46241 receive these services for free.

Friendly Cats: If the cat is friendly and can easily be picked up, contact FACE at 638-3223. **Feral Cats:** If you cannot safely handle the cat, contact Indyferal at 596-2300.

- After –hours: For urgent animal situations (such as a sick or injured animal) during off-hours (Mon-Fri after 5:30pm or on the weekend) call the IMPD non-emergency line at 327-3811. Information will be relayed to IACC.
