Clinic Supplies

Clumping cat litter
Yesterday's News Cat Litter
Kitten Milk Replacement (KMR)
Ziploc sandwich-sized bags for dispensing medications
Cat carriers (any size)
Electric heating pads for cats recovering from surgery
Towels (bath size)
Sheets to be used for trap covers
Paper towels
Distilled water
Bleach and laundry detergent
Trash bags (30 gallon and 45 gallon contractor grade)

Food Bank and Cat Shelter Supplies

Dry and canned cat food
Purina Weight Circles (click here for more info)
Small 6" paper plates or plastic lids to feed cats in traps
Food and water bowls
Empty Litter Buckets (w/ cover) - clean and dry if possible.
These are used to mix and distribute dry food to colony caretakers.

Straw bails (clean and dry)

Large pieces of scrap lumber to build feeding stations
30 gallon Sterilite plastic totes
– Grey or brown preferred, no bright colors (used for feeding stations and the production of cat shelters)
Wire dog cages - 2 ft x 3 ft min
– Used for rehabbing injured or ill stray and feral cats
