

## EARTIPPING INSTRUCTIONS

**E**artipping is the removal of the distal one-quarter of the left ear, which is approximately 3/8 inch or 1cm in an adult and proportionally smaller in a kitten.

Eartipping is performed while the cat is already anesthetized for spay/neuter surgery. There is little or no bleeding.



WHILE THE CAT IS UNDER ANESTHESIA

1. Apply pressure by pinching the ear between fingers



2. Use scissors to cut 1/4 tip of the left ear
3. Apply a small amount of Clotisol to the cut edge.
4. Do not redip the QTip in the Clotisol to avoid cross contamination
